

# Privacy Policy

## 1. Data Controller

The controller of personal data is quickevidence.med (“the Platform” or “the Service”). Contact: info@quickevidence.med

## 2. Purpose and scope

This Policy governs processing of users’ personal data and, where applicable, texts submitted through the Service. The Service processes clinical texts using NLP to provide informational analysis and suggestions.

⚠ The Service is not medical practice and does not replace professional medical advice, diagnosis, or treatment.

## 3. Data processed

Subscription/billing data: name, email, payment info.

Technical data: IP, logs, browser, device.

Clinical texts: must be anonymized; identifiable patient data must not be sent.

## 4. Purposes and legal bases

Service delivery (contract). Maintenance/improvement (legitimate interest). Legal compliance. Informational/marketing communications (consent). Outside the EU, equivalent principles apply (CCPA/CPRA; HIPAA where relevant).

## 5. Data retention

Subscription data: duration of contract and legal periods. Clinical texts: only during processing; then deleted unless legally required. After periods, data are erased or irreversibly anonymized.

## 6. Security

Reasonable technical and organizational measures are applied. Absolute removal of all traces cannot be guaranteed due to technical limits.

## 7. Disclosures and international transfers

No sale of data. Sharing only with tech providers (processors), authorities when required, or with express consent. For transfers outside the EEA, appropriate safeguards apply (SCCs or equivalents; HIPAA/CCPA compliance where relevant).

## 8. User rights

EU/GDPR: access, rectification, erasure, portability, restriction, objection, consent withdrawal, complaint to authority. US/CCPA-CPRA: know, correct, delete, limit sale, non-discrimination. Other jurisdictions: rights per local law. Requests to contact in section 1.

## **9. Minors**

Service not directed to children under 16 (or local minimum). No knowing collection of minors' data.

## **10. Cookies and similar tech**

The Platform uses cookies and similar technologies. See the Cookies Policy.

## **11. Limitation of liability**

Clinical text is processed automatically; accuracy not guaranteed. No liability for the User's use of outputs. Maximum liability: amounts paid in the prior 12 months.
